



## **2011 JACL Collegiate Washington, D.C. Leadership Conference**

### **Conference Description:**

The 2011 JACL Collegiate Washington, D.C. Leadership Conference is an intensive three-day leadership development program that introduces Asian Pacific American student leaders to the national policy-making arena. Participants will be briefed on legislative issues affecting the Asian Pacific American community and examine the role Asian Pacific American civil rights organizations play in affecting public policy in the nation's capital. They will also have the chance to meet and work with student leaders representing colleges and universities from throughout the country and learn ways to effectively address issues and create positive social change on their own campuses and beyond.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Applicant must be a full-time Asian Pacific American undergraduate freshman, sophomore or junior class student attending an accredited college or university.

### **Tuition:**

The program will select 12 participants to attend the conference. The tuition for each participant will be paid through a JACL grant from the UPS Foundation. The tuition includes airfare, lodging, meals (continental breakfast, lunch, dinner) and transportation during the conference.
